Requirements

Students are required to have a minimum of four classes totaling 12 hours from any of the 3000-4000 level courses listed below and maintain a minimum 2.0 Area of Specialization GPA. Be sure to check course prerequisite requirements. Please see the SPM advisor if interested in taking SPM courses not listed below. IMPORTANT: The Sport Management department will register students for a maximum of 2 SPM courses per term. It is recommended students plan for at least 3 semesters to complete the area. *Note that SPM 2000 is a required prerequisite for several of the area of specialization courses*.

Additional Note: The department allows Sport Management majors to register prior to business majors doing the ESS area of specialization. As such, they cannot assist you with registering until 3 weeks after the start of Advance Registration.
